## NIBRS Participation by State

In 2011, 29.4 percent of state UCR Programs and one agency in the District of Columbia reported all of their crime statistics via the NIBRS. This represents 28 percent of the U.S. population covered by UCR participants and accounted for 27 percent of all crime reported to the FBI UCR Program. Of the 36 states currently certified to report via the NIBRS, 15 states (Arkansas, Delaware, Idaho, Iowa, Michigan, Montana, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Vermont, Virginia, and West Virginia) submit all their crime data via the NIBRS.
