## NICS FFL Quick Reference Guide

#### What is a Business Day?

A business day is any 24-hour day beginning at 12:01 a.m. the day after a check was initiated, in which state offices are open. A business day does not include Saturday, Sunday, or state holidays.

The table below advises when a firearm can be transferred if no response is received:
