The **Introduction to Future Law Enforcement Youth Academy (FLEYA)** is a one-day program that will be offered on three different days in July 2021 at Yale University’s West Campus in Orange, CT.

Friday, July 30, 2021	8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Selected students will be allowed to attend **one** of the sessions (not all three).

Selected students must meet below outlined eligibility criteria.

Open application period: February 1, 2021 – April 23, 2021 at 5 p.m. Eastern Standard Time

(Note: NO Google Docs or applications requiring a password to access will be accepted.)

All applicants will be notified via email if they are moving on in the selection process by Friday April 30, 2021. The FLEYA program is free of charge to accepted students.
