On 08/05/2016, a female was walking her dog in Marymoor Park along the Sammamish River Trail when the suspect grabbed her and dragged her into the bushes. The suspect beat the victim about the face and neck, twisted her left arm behind her, and strangled her with his shoelace. The suspect told the victim he was going to kill her and that he was hungry. The suspect fled after the victim's screams were heard by someone passing by. While he was fleeing the suspect lost both of his shoes. There was a concert in Marymoor Park at the time. The suspect is believed to be transient.
