REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$20,000 for information leading to the arrest of Bhadreshkumar Chetanbhai Patel.

CAUTION

Bhadreshkumar Chetanbhai Patel is wanted for allegedly killing his wife while they were both working at a donut shop in Hanover, Maryland. On April 12, 2015, Patel allegedly struck his wife multiple times with an object inside the business and then fled the scene. A local arrest warrant was issued in the District Court of Maryland for Anne Arundel County on April 13, 2015, and Patel was charged with first degree murder, second degree murder, first degree assault, second degree assault, and dangerous weapon with intent to injure. A federal arrest warrant was issued in the United States District Court, District of Maryland, Baltimore, Maryland, on April 20, 2015, after Patel was charged with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution.
