


**Unlawful Flight to Avoid Prosecution - Murder**

## REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest of Saul Aguilar, Jr.

### REMARKS

Aguilar reportedly is a heavy methamphetamine user. Aguilar has ties to Mexicali, Mexico.

#### CAUTION

Saul Aguilar, Jr. is wanted for his alleged involvement in the murder of his ex-girlfriend in Los Angeles, California. In December of 1997, the victim was found in her home with a shotgun wound to her upper torso.

A state arrest warrant was issued on January 5, 1998, by the Los Angeles County, California Superior Court, after Aguilar was charged with murder. Aguilar was charged with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution and a federal arrest warrant was issued by the United States District Court, Central District of California, on June 23, 1998.
