DETAILS

The Federal Bureau of Investigation's Washington Field Office and the Metropolitan Police Department in Washington, D.C., are seeking the public's assistance in identifying the individual(s) responsible for the death of 3-year-old Ty'ah Settles. On Friday, May 3, 2024, at approximately 9:10 pm, Settles was shot inside a vehicle in the 2300 block of Hartford Street, SE, Washington, D.C. She was taken to a fire station, unconscious and unresponsive, and then transported to Children's National Medical Center where, despite all life saving efforts, she was pronounced dead.
