On 09/22/2009 at approximately 10:00am, the body of Joan Rosenthal, a 75year-old white female, was discovered outside of her residence in Tiburon, California. Tiburon is a small town located approximately 20 miles north of San Francisco. Rosenthal was found by her housecleaner inside her enclosed front yard near her front door. She had sustained a single gunshot wound to her head. Investigators determined the time of death to be approximately 9:00pm the night before on 09/21/2009. Rosenthal was recently widowed and living alone. She was a grandmother, library volunteer, had a small circle of friends, and did not travel much outside of Tiburon. Her homicide is still unsolved.
