Jack Allen Shultz was last seen on or about 11/24/1994 at his home in DeSoto, Kansas. Shultz was known to disappear for periods of time; thus, he was not reported missing until 1/4/1995. Shultz had previously worked in construction; however, no wages have been reported since 1994. At the time of his disappearance, he did not have access to a vehicle. Personal belongings were left in the victim's home and foul play is suspected. He was known to frequent bars and was a drug and alcohol user. Shultz may have had or displayed characteristics of Huntington's disease. Past dental records indicated that Shultz had "bad teeth" and gingivitis, which may lead to periodontitis. Dental records, fingerprints, and familial DNA are available for comparison.
