On 03/30/2008, the skeletal remains of an unidentified 25 – 35-year-old white (possibly mixed race) female were discovered by a fisherman on the north bank of the Georgiana Slough Levee in Sacramento, CA. Investigators believe the victim's death occurred in late 2004. The victim was fully dressed and wearing various items of jewelry, including a frog pendant (shown above). The anthropological examination indicated the victim is predominately European ancestry with unknown components of Asian and African admixture. DNA is in CODIS at the National Level. Dental charting and X-rays are also available for comparison purposes.
