On 11/14/2007, the unidentified skeletal remains of a black female were discovered in a remote wooded area in LaVergne, Tennessee. It is estimated the victim had been deceased since the spring or summer of 2007. No clothing was located in the area of these unidentified human remains; however, jewelry was found. The victim had some dental work completed on her teeth.
