





ViCAP ALERT: Unidentified Victim

On May 2, 1996, the body of an unidentified female was found in an undeveloped area of SW Albuquerque. The body was in a state of advanced decomposition. Blunt force injuries included fracture of the facial bones, skull and left tibia and fibula.
