Remains found on 12/20/1984 in Sneads, Florida (Jackson County)

Race: White Sex: Female

Age: 18-25 years old

<u>Height</u>: Approximately 5'0" Hair: Strawberry Blonde

<u>Distinguishing Characteristics</u>: The victim may have had strawberry blonde hair and large or sagging breasts. The victim has a multicolored tattoo of a small bee or butterfly on her left breast; possibly one tulip leaf with possible initials on her upper left chest area; and one red flower with green leaves on her left shoulder. The victim's teeth are in very poor condition having no indication of prior dental work.

<u>Jewelry</u>: Wedding band with engagement ring (costume type jewelry) recovered.

<u>Details of Discovery</u>: The victim's nude remains were discovered in Sneads, Florida (Jackson County) along Interstate 10 at the 149 mile marker. Forensic analysis indicates the victim had been at the location between 8-11 months. No clothing was found at the scene.
