On 03/29/2023, Kansas City Police Department responded to a fatality collision involving a pedestrian (W/M/30-40) at I-435 and I-70 in Kansas City, Missouri. A semi-truck driver was driving southbound on I-435 and entering the I-70 Highway eastbound ramp when the pedestrian crossed his path, and the driver was unable to avoid the collision.
