


On November 18, 1968, this male homicide victim was recovered along the Pennsylvania Turnpike near Downingtown, Chester County, PA. He was wearing a rust colored sweater, brown plaid pants, brown shoes with buckles, and was covered with a dark blue navy pea coat. The victim had a tattoo on his right upper arm of a bulldog wearing a helmet with the letters "USMC" underneath and a tattoo on his left forearm of a "bird in flight". The victim likely served in the U.S. Marine Corps (USMC).

Law enforcement agencies should bring this information to the attention of all Missing Persons Units and Crime Analysis Units. A partial dental chart and fingerprints are available. Any agency with a missing person case that possibly matches this unidentified victim may contact either:
